## 2017 Stats for EDR

- **91%** of all death records for 2017 were completed either fully or partially on the EDR system (up from 74% in 2016)
- In November 2017, **73%** of all death records were completed fully electronic in EDR
- There were **681** new EDR users in 2017, of which **415** are new physicians
- Over **42** new offices came on board with EDR
- **94%** of Funeral Homes use EDR, and **86%** of Coroners
