Who Should Attend

- Families and friends who are affected by the disappearance of a loved one
- The event is free and open to the public.

What To Bring

- Families are encouraged to bring photos along with medical and dental records of their missing loved ones. If families would like to provide DNA (cheek swabs) at the event, two biologically related family members of the missing person are encouraged (not required) to attend.

What To Expect At This Event

- Law enforcement representatives will be available to meet with families to take reports and gather information about missing persons.
- A private family support group will be held from 12:30 pm to 2:30 pm. Space is limited, so **reservations are required to participate in the support group.**
- Several non-profits, law enforcement agencies, and forensic professionals will be available to answer questions and provide information
